Please be advised that the abeyance code **NG04** has been assigned to the issue of the \$80.00 entitlement in situations when employees in assigned road service (i.e. road switchers) who have given notice of rest, and are relieved within the terminal after 10 hours on duty

The abeyance code must be referenced on all IP claims regarding this issue. It should be noted that this issue is currently in dispute and the Company maintains that this payment is not payable. Notwithstanding, the Company has agreed to hold the IP claims of this nature in abeyance until the matter is resolved.

Until a final arbitration ruling is made or matter resolved regarding your claim(s) it will be held in abeyance and can be viewed in your time slip inquiry displayed as "awaiting approval".

If making a similar claim(s) of this type in the future, please submit as a <u>stand-alone IP claim</u> and indicate that these claims are to be held in abeyance by typing "Over 10 Abeyance – NG04" in the remarks field. Please ensure to include the dollar amount or amount of miles that is being claimed.

Note that you will not receive another declination letter on these types of claims until the issue is resolved.
